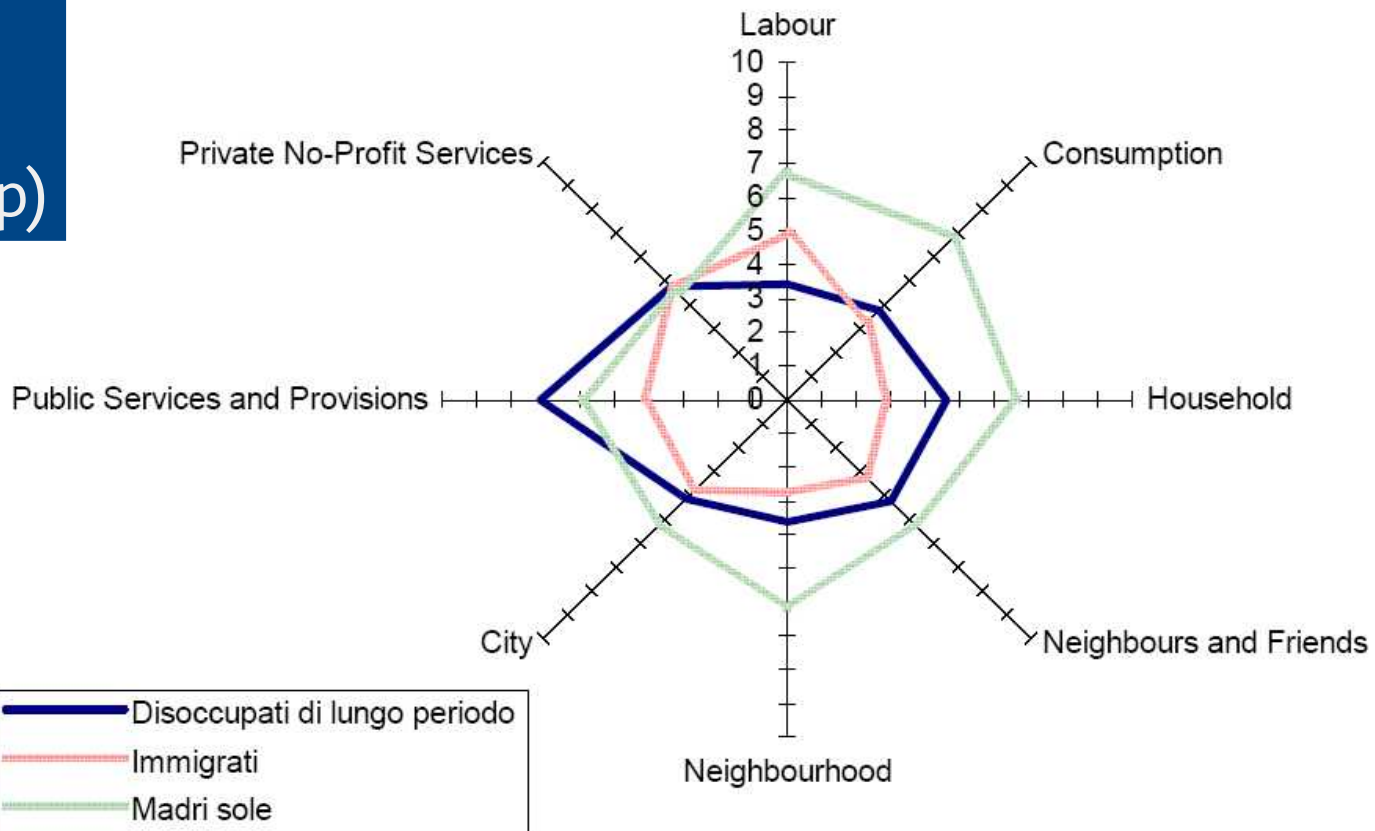

Labour	3,44	unstable jobs, working once in a while
Consumption	3,78	Market is used for food and other primary needs only
Household	4,61	co-habitants over 18 give some support but no other support from the origin family is given
Neighbours and Friends	4,22	few support contacts with neighbours and almost no support from friends
Neighbourhood	3,61	The local space is used only in an scarcely and in an instrumental way (e.g. shopping, but not for jobs,...). Very few knots are there
City	4,17	The city is used only for services and provisions (in one sphere of regulation, e.g. "she goes to her mother in another neighbourhood for child care) that are not available in the neighbourhood
Public Services and Provisions	7,17	Use of social services for getting monetary and non monetary support besides other supports
Private No-Profit Services	4,78	Rare use of third sector agencies in the neighbourhood for information
